BusterSci I just want to throw out a comment regarding the stage profile, important if 07-21 05:09

you're guessing at winners. It's also important if you're looking at graphs and charts in general. First, the vertical scale of this stage profile is around 0-1200m. Yesterday's scale was 0-2400m and Wednesday's was 0-2700m. That makes today's lumps look a lot bigger than they actually are. Second, depending on what maps you use, the horizontal scale may be similarly dissimilar. for instance, today we have 222.5km stretched across our screen. If we go back to stage 13, we only have 101km. Packing in a longer stage into the same chart dimensions compresses the perception of the length of each lump, and therefor also makes the climbs look steeper.
